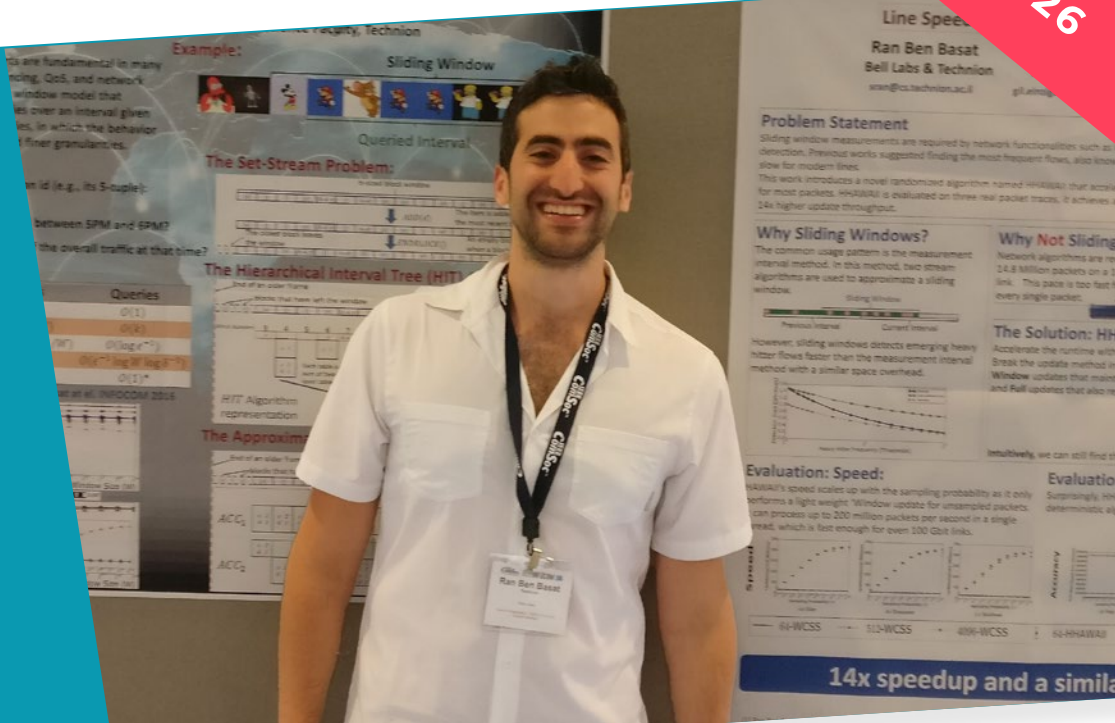

Dr. Ran Ben Basat, Israeli Postdoctoral Scholar at Harvard

The Zuckerman Israeli Postdoctoral Scholars Program provides additional support to Israeli PhD graduates who have been accepted to a postdoctoral program with a stipend at an American university. Candidates are encouraged to apply to a university that offers more specialized training than they would find in Israel.



In the 2026-2027 academic year, 5 Israeli postdoctoral scholarships will be given out. Two out of the 5 scholarships will be reserved for women.

DURATION, FUNDING AND ELIGIBILITY

- Zuckerman Israeli Postdoctoral Scholarships are for up to two years.
- Zuckerman Israeli Postdoctoral Scholars receive a stipend of:
 - **\$20,000 US** per academic year, plus a
 - **\$5,000 US** travel allowance to return to Israel once per academic year during their postdoctoral appointment.
- Candidates must hold a Ph.D. degree from one of the 8 participating universities, or if still studying for a Ph.D., must submit their Ph.D. thesis before October 1, 2026.
- Candidates who commenced their postdoctoral position before October 2025 are not eligible to apply.
- Candidates must be accepted to a postdoctoral program at an American university or research institute that includes a stipend for work and study. They must obtain consent from a potential hosting supervisor at that university or research institute.
