Post-Doctoral Fellows at Guangdong Technion – Israel Institute of Technology (GTIIT)

The GTIIT management is happy to announce a call for excellent candidates for post-doctoral studies (Post-doctorate studies will start no later than 5 years after receiving a Doctorate degree), as follows:

For excellent candidates who are co-mentored by at least one GTIIT faculty member and at least one Technion faculty member, a two-year option is being offered. In this option, the GTIIT faculty member pays 1/3 of the post-doctoral stipend, the Technion faculty member pays 1/3 of the post-doctoral stipend, and GTIIT pays 1/3 of the post-doctoral stipend. The program can be extended for a second year after the submission of a written research report and justification at the end of year 1. The post-doctoral student is expected to spend time both at the Technion in Israel and at the GTIIT campus in China. At the end of year 2, the post-doctoral student is required to submit a draft of a research proposal to establish a group at GTIIT as an independent faculty member.

Faculty members should apply of Candidates to Prof. Moris Eisen, the Pro-Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs (PVCAA) of GTIIT to Mrs. Ronit Mayer (via <u>gtiitrecruit@technion.ac.il</u>), including:

- A detailed CV, including a publication list where the impact factor of each journal is listed.
- A research proposal justifying and describing the research the post-doctoral student will conduct with his/her mentor(s). The proposal should be approved by the mentor(s).
- Letters of recommendation from the mentor(s), the PhD advisor, and at least one additional person who can attest to the scientific abilities of the candidate.

Applications should be submitted by July 1st, 2024
