<u>The 2025 Call for Applications – Schmidt Science Fellows</u>

Schmidt Science Fellows is a unique program for postdoctoral scholars. It is intended for curious and creative graduates who are interested in pursuing ambitious postdoctoral research in a field different from their PhD. This scientific pivot from the PhD research field to a distinct postdoctoral research field during the fellowship is core to the Schmidt Science Fellows program. The Technion is among a select group of the world's leading science and engineering institutions collaborating with the Schmidt Science Fellows program to identify candidates for each year's fellowship cohort.

We have the privilege of nominating up to six candidates in the fields of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM). Eligible applicants are PhD students who are expected to complete all requirements for the conferral of their PhD between May 15, 2024, and June 30, 2025, and can start their fellowship in July 2025 or October 2025.
